Awards Information

Eligibility Criteria for Merit Awards

1. African American student or student of African descent;
2. Resident of Pasadena, Altadena or Sierra Madre or a student of a Pasadena Unified School District high school;
3. Student graduating from high school in 2022;
4. GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale (unweighted); and
5. Acceptance to a four-year college or university.

Eligibility Criteria for Pyramid Awards (1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 OR 1, 2, 3 & 6)

1. African American student or student of African descent;
2. Resident of Pasadena, Altadena or Sierra Madre or a student of a Pasadena Unified School District high school;
3. Student graduating from high school in 2022;
4. GPA of 2.5 – 2.99 on a 4.0 scale (unweighted);
5. Acceptance to a four-year college/university, community college, or career and technical education school/program;
6. GPA of 3.0 and above on a 4.0 scale (unweighted) AND acceptance to community college, or career and technical education school/program.

The applicant must include all required documents and photograph as listed below and email the entire application packet to academicawards.dstpac@gmail.com with the applicant name in the subject line, **no later than February 25, 2022.**

Application Requirements

The application packet must include the following documents and photograph:

- Completed and signed **typed** application;
- Essay (typed, double-spaced);
- **ONE** letter of recommendation, **on official letterhead**, and signed from **school** personnel (e.g. school administrator, teacher, counselor, coach);
- **ONE** letter of recommendation, on letterhead and signed, from a **community** person (e.g. organization sponsor, employer, minister, neighbor— **NOT** school affiliated, **NOT** a relative);
- Official high school transcript(s) **including cumulative GPA** emailed from school registrar to academicawards.dstpac@gmail.com with applicant name in subject line;
- S.A.T. or A.C.T. scores, if required by post-secondary educational institution; and
- Recent photograph

If all of the above submission requirements are met, the applicant will be invited for an interview. The interview is a mandatory component of the selection process.

The completed application packet must be RECEIVED no later than Friday, February 25, 2022.

Incomplete, hand-written, or late applications WILL be disqualified without further review.
